1. Parents and racers will conduct themselves in a manner that represents good sportsmanship and fair play at all times. Fair play is defined as the following:
  - a. Be knowledgeable of KIDS PRO ICE rules and regulations, and follow them.
  - b. Do not deliberately cut off or run into other racers during hotlaps or races.
  - c. Promote good sportsmanship by both parents and racers.
2. Parents and racers must refrain from foul language at all times.
3. Parents and racers will be equally representative of good sportsmanship in winning and losing.
4. Parents and racers will treat all equipment (theirs and others) in the proper manner.
5. Parents and racers will not show or exhibit derogatory conduct toward any race official before, during or after the race.
6. Parents will make sure all racers have proper safety equipment on machines and the racers themselves.
